Rural Revitalization Symposium 2023:
Over 20 National & International Experts Celebrated
Achievements in Regenerating Rural Heritage & Community

Over 20 experts from mainland China, Hong Kong, Australia and Japan presented their latest research, projects and academic insights at the inaugural Rural Revitalization Symposium at the School of Architecture, The Chinese University of Hong Kong on 24 August 2023, Thursday.

The one-day symposium, co-hosted by CUHK and the Wu Zhi Qiao (Bridge to China) Charitable Foundation, was the opening event of the 50th anniversary of the Social Science Faculty of CUHK. Sessions exploring rural heritage conservation, landscapes, policy, and engagement through international lenses were shared to a live audience of 150, plus over 10,000 online participants.

Professor Wong Kam-sing, Chairman of Wu Zhi Qiao (Bridge to China) Charitable Foundation, addressed the event, "WZQ integrates the diverse talents of youth actively participating in low-carbon rural architecture, in a bid to support sustainable development." Professor Chiu Chi-yue, Dean of Social Science, CUHK, highlighted the meaningful efforts of the CUHK countryside conservation team led by Professor Thomas Chung of the School of Architecture, and encouraged researchers and students to look for multi-disciplinary teaching and learning opportunities in rural revitalisation.

The Symposium was accompanied by the 5-day Xue Wu Zhi Annual Interflow Camp that connected university students from mainland China and Hong Kong by visiting rural project sites of the CUHK research team together with symposium scholars. A multi-media exhibition at the event venue showcasing CUHK's various countryside regeneration projects is presented by Countryside Curators Ltd., a social enterprise supported by CUHK'S-KPF dedicated to regenerating remote Hong Kong communities by reconnecting people to place with a collaborative approach to create positive social impacts.

The Symposium was concluded by a roundtable discussion on the futures of the countryside, learning from mainland China and way forward for Hong Kong. Discussions emphasized community empowerment and the common cause of reimagining rural-urban understanding. The hosts anticipated more collaborations between universities in research and youth exchange to champion the regeneration of rural heritage and community in Hong Kong, mainland China and beyond.







#### 鄉村振興研討會 2023:

超過20多位國內外專家分享復育鄉村遺產與社區的成果

來自中國內地、中國香港、澳大利亞和日本的20多位專家於2023年8月24日(星期四)在香港中文大學建築學院舉行的首屆鄉村振興研討會上,展示他們的最新研究、項目和學術見解。

全天的研討會由中大與無止橋慈善基金會合辦,是中大社會科學院成立五十週年的開幕活動。會議向150名現場觀眾以及超過10,000名線上參與者以國際視角探討鄉村遺產保護、景觀、政策和參與。

無止橋慈善基金會主席黃錦星教授在活動致辭時表示:「無止橋結合青年多元參與,投入示範低碳鄉建,支持可持續發展。」中大社會科學院院長趙志裕教授強調,由建築學院鍾宏亮教授領導的中大鄉郊保育團隊的工作別具意義,並鼓勵研究人員和學生在鄉郊保育和鄉村振興中尋找跨學科的教學機會。


研討會同期舉行為期五天的「學無止年度交流營」;參與營會的內地和香港大學生,與研討會學者一同實地考察中大研究團隊的鄉郊保育項目。研討會現場亦設有由Countryside Curators策展的多媒體展覽,展示中大多個鄉郊保育項目。Countryside Curators是由中大可持續知識轉移項目基金支持的社會企業,致力以協作方式將人們與地方重新聯繫,創造積極的社會關係,從而重建偏遠的香港社區及為社會整體帶來正面影響。

研討會最後的圓桌討論,與會者一同討論鄉村的未來、取中國內地之經及香港之橋樑角色。討論強調社區賦權和重新構想城鄉關係的共同事業。主辦方期待大學之間在研究和青年交流方面開展更多合作,以支持內地、香港及其他地區鄉村遺產和社區的復興。




